Notifying the Public of Rights Under Title VI

- ✓ The **City of Shawano** operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, and national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act. Any person who believes she or he has been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint with the **City of Shawano**.

<sup>1</sup> Title VI regulations require the **City of Shawano** to inform customers and the public of their rights under Title VI regulations by posting a Title VI public notice. The Title VI notice must include:

- ✓ A statement that the agency operates programs without regard to race, color or national origin.
- ✓ Information on how to request additional information about the agency's Title VI obligations, including information on how to file a complaint, the location of the complaint form, etc.
- ✓ Information on how to request Title VI information in another language, if required

The Public Notice should be posted in the following locations: website, public areas of the agencies office, inside vehicles, rider guides/schedules and transit shelters/facilities.
