ELECTRIC RATE CASE 5350-ER-112

Shawano Municipal Utilities (SMU) has filed an application with the Public Service Commission (PSC) to increase electric rates. The rates were last increased on January 31, 2021. The change is necessary to reflect changes in operating costs and purchased power costs. The requested increase in rates is an overall increase of 1%. The actual increase to individual customers will vary with electricity usage, class of service and the ultimate rates authorized by the Public Service Commission.
