 2nd Installment: Due by Wednesday April 30, 2026. Please use second payment stub.
 3rd Installment: Due by Thursday July 31, 2026. Please use third payment stub.

If you mail your payment and require a receipt, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope along with your tax bill and payment. A receipt will **NOT** be provided unless a **self-addressed, stamped envelope is included**. Please contact City Hall at 715-526-6138 with any questions.

Yard Waste and Wood Waste Service Information

Christmas trees will be collected during the month of January on residents' normal collection day.

Yard waste is collected **every week** on residents' normal collection day. Yard waste consists of grass, leaves and garden waste. All yard waste must be in a properly marked 25 Gallon container or a paper biodegradable yard waste bag. Containers are not to exceed 50 pounds in weight. Residents are limited to 6 bags or containers per week. Please note: if there is any wood waste in the container or bag, it will not be collected.



Wood waste is collected **every other week** (opposite of recycling) on residents' normal collection day. Wood waste consists of branches, tree and/or shrub trimmings. Bulky limbs and cuttings should not exceed four feet in length. Wood waste should **NOT** be in a container – place it directly at the curb.



The city will not pick up entire trees. If you have a contractor, take down a tree, that contractor is also responsible for disposing of any waste.

Shawano residents can dispose of their household hazardous waste at **Brown County Household Hazardous Waste Facility** or the **Marathon County Hazardous Waste Facility**. Fees will apply. If you have specific questions about acceptable items, please contact the facility directly at the contact numbers listed below.
